Giulio, Ana and Damir discussed their ideas about the architecture and technologies which might be used for the back end.

The decision about the front-end technologies is to use: phonegap, backbone, javascript, html and css.

Different possibilities for back-end as a service were discussed. The most interesting possibilities, which were found are App42 and Baasbox, which both have their pros and cons. The team decided to take a more detailed look at them and decide which is the better solution.

The other technologies which will be used for the back-end are either C# / ASP.NET or Java with the usage of the proposed by the client tool SCase for automatic generation of services. Both solutions will provide REST services for usage by the client.

The engine is going to integrate with the back-end to obtain user data and communicate with stores that provide gift options.

Ana explained the team how Kanbanise works.

The written user stories were discussed. They should be slightly changed in order to be annotated using SCase. Alex and Damir are going to handle this task.
